Competition Guidelines:

Entry Forms must be signed by the official Association or Club coach only. Entry forms without a signed declaration will not be permitted to take part in the competition. **Entry forms must be received with full payment by Saturday 21st April.** No late entries will be accepted on the day.

Only official coaches may approach tatami and control tables.

All competitors must be fully insured by their Association and should be aware that all events will operate under WUKF rules. Slight amendments by the organisers and Chief Referee may be required to ensure a safe and smooth running of the event. All coaches and officials should contact the organiser before 28/04/18 for update on any rule changes.

The minimum number of competitors per event category is at the discretion of the organiser.

Spectator entry fees are £5 per person with under 16s allowed for free, which is payable at the spectator's entrance on the day where you will receive a coloured wristband. Spectators are not to act as coaches or officials or permitted to stand next to the tatami area.

Any spectators/competitors or coaches infringing the above guidelines will be asked to leave the sports hall, with no refund given and the name of the club concerned reported to their Association Executive.

Rules of Kata and Kumite

This is a summary of rules for the tournaments and has been created using WUKF guidelines.

Shobu Ippon:

The match is won by a two Waza-ari or one Ippon. WUKF approved Shobu Sanbon mitts must be worn by all competitors aged 12 years & below. Competitors aged 13 & Above must wear WUKF approved Ippon mitts, which will be provided by Kanzen Karate. Head contact is not permitted for competitors Aged 10 Years & Below.

Shobu Nihon:

The match can be won by four Waza-ari or two Ippon. WUKF approved Shobu Sanbon mitts must be worn by all competitors. Head and Body pads must be worn and will be provided by Kanzen Karate. Gumshields are optional.

Shobu Sanbon:

The match is won by six Waza-ari or three Ippon. WUKF Approved Shobu Sanbon mitts must be worn by all competitors. Age 13 Years & above only.

Additional Information:

In all events, the highest maximum individual score that can be given at any one time is Ippon. The lowest score that can be given is a Waza-ari.

All Kumite events will be run with a Referee, Mirror Judge & Arbitrator. Arbitrator can assist in the decision-making process.

Competitors must wear a Red belt (AKA) or White Belt (SHIRO) to identify themselves during the Kumite events and must match the colour of mitts. In every event the competitor must wear protection in accordance with WUKF ruling. The timing of bouts will be the same as the WUKF rules, but can be subject to change, depending on the smooth running of events.

Gumshield must be worn by all competitors except for Shobu Nihon (Head Guard Required).

Groin Guards are optional for all competitors.

Chest Guards must be worn by all female competitors Aged 13 Years & Above.

Team Ippon Rotation Kumite:

A team must be made up of a minimum of three competitors, with one reserve fighter (optional). The duration of the match will be 4 minutes running time. The clock will stop only when the Referee requests "Time". Each competitor must fight at least once and for at least 15 seconds during the prescribed time, failure to do so will result in disqualification. The match will be won by six Waza-ari or three Ippon. If this score is not reached the team with highest score at the end of the prescribed time will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie, the team the highest number of Ippon will be declared the winner. If there is no clear winner the referee will Soremade followed by a call for Hantei.

Kata:

Kata events will run using a point based system. Round 1 will be scored from 5.0 to 7.0 (average 6.0). Round 2 will be scored from 6.0 to 8.0 (average 7.0). Round 3 (final round) will be scored from 7.0 to 9.0 (average 8.0).

All Kata events will be run to WUKF rules, including the level of Kata competitors can perform in each round. Bunkai is not required in the Team Kata. Team Kata will be made up of 3 individuals.

The number of rounds will be the same as WUKF rules where possible, but can be subject to change, depending on the smooth running of events.

Competitors 4th Kyu & Below as well as those aged 8 & below **may repeat Kata**. All competitors 3rd Kyu & Above **cannot repeat Kata**. In Kata events, you are only permitted to wear the belt that you are graded to.

Photography Policy:

Photographers will be present for the duration of the event. If individuals do not wish to be featured on official photography, then the organisers must be notified by the Association or Club Coach prior to the event.

Appeals:

If a problem arises on the day of the competition only the Head Coach can approach the Chief Referee. If the Head Coach is not satisfied with the decision of the Chief Referee there is an appeals process that can be followed (official protest written down and signed by the Head Coach, then handed to the Chief Referee with the protest fee of £50. An appeals jury will be selected of the highest-level referees at the competition and from a different association. They will then look at the protest and review all relevant information and make their decision. If the protest is upheld, then the protest fee will be returned. If it is not upheld, then the protest fee will go towards all admin fees for the protest.
